# **Your California Privacy Rights**

Under the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018 (CCPA), California residents may have certain rights regarding their data, including:

- The right to know the categories of personal information we've collected and the sources from which we obtained the information.
- The right to know the business purposes for sharing personal information.
- The right to know the categories of third parties with whom we've shared personal information.
- The right to access the specific pieces of personal information we've collected and right to request the deletion of your information (see "Your Rights and Choices" below).

You may only make a verifiable consumer request for access or data portability twice within a 12-month period.
